Language	We will discuss the letter "O", read "On the First Night of Chanukah", "Wise Up Silly Owl", practice saying the word "Chanukah", and read "This is a Dreidel"	We will be introduced to the letter "C", we will read "My First Kwanzaa Book", "Seven Days of Kwanzaa", "Cars", and we will look for the letter C in our books	We will read "Elmo's Christmas", talk about Rudolph, read a poem about Christmas, practice saying "Merry Christmas" and "Happy Holidays"	School Closed
Cognitive Development	We will look at pictures of different Hanukkah symbols, learn about a triangle, work on reading comprehension, match triangles, and count to eight	We will make cats, discuss the colors of Kwanzaa, look at pictures of Kwanzaa shapes, go on a "brown" hunt, and a letter "C" hunt	We will put a face on Elmo, make a list for Santa, work on puzzles, and dot paint an elf picture	School Closed
Fun Fitness/ Motor Skills	We will use small pegs, connectors, "fly" like owls in the classroom, play "Ring around the Rosie", and pretend to be an octopus	We will do morning stretches, head, shoulders, knees and toes, log rolls, butterfly stretches, use push toys and do yoga	We will stretch in the morning, have fun in the tunnel, jumping jacks, hop on one foot, throw a ball, stack blocks, and pretend to be elephants	School Closed
Creative Sides	We will dot paint the letter "O", make a star of David, make owls, make triangle trees, and make an octopus	We will dot paint a letter c, makes Kwanzaa candles, a Kwanzaa chain, gingerbread men, and color a picture of cars	We will color a picture of Elmo, make Santa masks, elephant handprints, make a present for Mommy and Daddy and decorate a welcome banner"	School Closed
Self Help/Life Skills	We will practice putting on our coats, practice using our forks and spoons, practice folding a blanket, walking down stairs, and pushing in our chairs	We will practice using our manners, help putting out our nap stuff, help clean up after snack, say thank you, and push in our chairs	We will practice waiting our turns, discuss being nice to our friends, signing 'please', putting our cups away, and welcome our friends and family to our school	School Closed
Sensory Stimulation	We will make hand prints using paint, Hanukkah rubbings, texture of feathers, shaving cream fun, taste cheerios for the letter O	We will compare textures, we will watch ice melt and turn paint a different color, make a gingerbread house, bubble fun	We will use paint and decorate our class Christmas tree, explore the touch of cotton balls, use our paint bags to practice drawing a heart, sand art and experience the different types of food	School Closed
